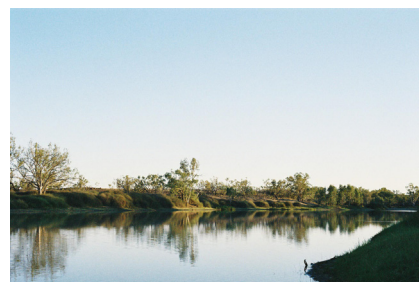
Then, on to iconic Tibooburra, capital of the Corner Country, before heading west through Sturt National
