Whether passing through, or planning to stay for a while, there is much to see and do in Milparinka and around the district. Here's a few ideas.



The Barracks Visitor Information Centre

At the heart of the Milparinka Heritage Precinct is the former police station and barracks. Today the building functions as a Visitor Information Centre with local and regional information and souvenirs. Call in for a complimentary cup of tea or coffee.

Milparinka's Proto Resources Mining Interpretation Centre .

Located in the fully restored nineteenth century gaol, you will find no bushrangers here, but a chronicle of mining history from the 1880s to the present day.



Variety Children's Park

Venture into the children's learning area to work a model of a dry-blower, or simply rest in the shade of a log shelter. Remnant mining equipment continues the learning experience for young and young at heart.

Sturt's Depot Glen and Mt Browne Goldfields

Why not continue your own exploration of the Milparinka region with a visit to the now famous Depot Glen and cairn on Mt Poole? Or, head out to the former goldfields of Mt Browne for a spot of gold detecting! Guides are available from the Barracks Visitor Information Centre.

Courthouse Local History and Family History Centre

An attraction in its own right, this superb example of colonial architecture houses a collection of local history information and memorabilia from the pioneering families of the early days.
